### Tjapukai

At Tjapukai Aboriginal Cultural Park you will be greeted by your Indigenous guide who will walk you through the Park. The experience includes 'bush tucker', didgeridoo performance, hunting & weapons demonstrations, spear & boomerang throwing and the famous Tjapukai Dance Troupe.



### Skyrail

Spread across 7.5kms of pristine tropical rainforest, Skyrail Cableway silently glides above the rainforest canopy over rivers and waterfalls before descending through the layers to two mid-canopy boardwalks for the ultimate rainforest experience.



### Rainforestation

Set in 40 hectares of tropical rainforest, Rainforestation offers a number of unique attractions. Get a different view of the rainforest aboard the amphibious Army Duck; tickle your taste buds with some tropical fruit; or surround yourself in wildlife by holding a koala or feeding a kangaroo in the Wildlife Park.



### Barron Falls Lookout

The Barron Falls is one of the most visited sites in the World Heritage Tropical Rainforest. Here, the waters of the Barron River come to the edge of the Atherton Tablelands plateau and cascade over the sheer drop, down through the lush tropical rainforest and into the Barron Gorge.



### Kuranda Village

Explore this picturesque village, set in the World Heritage listed rainforest with 1200 species of flowering plants. Admire the historic buildings which now accommodate restaurants, cafes, bars and shops selling handcrafted goods, Aboriginal artefacts and art.

Australian Butterfly Sanctuary's 3,666 cubic metre aviary is home to more than 1500 magnificent tropical butterflies.

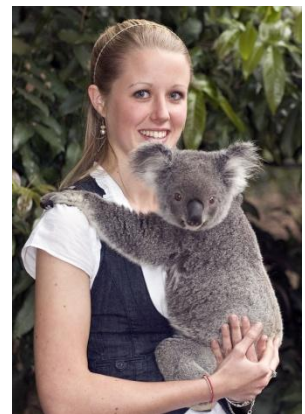
At Kuranda Koala Gardens you can cuddle a koala, see snakes, crocodiles, wallabies and wombats.

Various walking tracks surround the village; from easy trails to a more strenuous bushwalk.
